PALMER, Alaska, June 9. (AP)—Heat records in the Matanuska valley have been broken the last three days. Sunday's temperature mounting to 92.

Don L. Irwin, manager of the Matanuska experiment station, said the previous high was 90 degrees and that the heat wave is expected to continue through tomorrow. Maximum temperatures for Thursday, Friday and Saturday were 90, 87 and 91, respectively.
